Carl Orff Canada's first virtual National Conference, Intersections 2022 will include our traditional Opening Ceremonies with a virtual twist – COC's first ever Cross Canada Virtual Orff Ensemble. We invite teachers and students from across Canada to participate in our virtual Orff ensemble. The video performance of a new arrangement of Sherryl Sewepagaham's Kahkiyaw Osk-âyak (All the Young People) will be shared at the Intersections 2022 Opening Ceremonies, Friday, April 29, 2022.

Teachers from across Canada will assist students to learn their part and to create a video that will be submitted to the project.

### **HOW TO PARTICIPATE:**

- The score and sample recording are included [here](#). Please review them prior to determining whether or not to participate.
- Students will learn one individual part (vocal, recorder or instrumental) plus the Unison Coda part.
- To participate, complete this [form](#) by October 30. Each school is limited to 2 student submissions.
- By mid-November teachers who have volunteered students will receive an email including student media releases, practice tracks and detailed instructions for filming and submitting videos.
- Practice with your students and submit videos by February 11, 2022.

### **CONSIDERATIONS:**

- This project is intended for individual student participation, not a class project.
- Teachers will rehearse with students so they can comfortably perform their part along with a practice track. Students need to be able to perform with a click track playing through earphones. This will ensure that all audio parts line up in the final video.
